Now that the Local Elections are over we have great pleasure to announce that all three Conservatives were elected to represent you in the ward.

The defeated candidates included three fielded by an Upmminster based **political** Residents Association who like us, are registered with the Electoral Commission as a political party under registration number:PP38. In the weeks leading up to the election, our candidates gratefully received help and support from our hard working and dedicated team of volunteers. The candidates visited every road within the ward and had the pleasure of speaking to many local residents. Since the previous election in 2014, they have undertaken many individual issues for residents and now as Councillors we pledge to continue to do this. They also explained the Conservative policies for the future, including the intention of to step up capital spending on our roads and pavements.

HORNCHURCH POLICE STATION



Following **OUR** campaign over many months to save 'Hornchurch Police Station' Conservative led Havering Council, earlier this year, launched a legal challenge against the London Mayor Sadiq Khan and the Metropolitan Police plans to close our police station and all local Police team offices with the exception of Elm Park.

Because of reporting restrictions during the local election period it has not been possible to say much about the progress on this issue. We are pleased to say however that in meetings between officials the end result looks very encouraging.

As a result of these meetings it would appear at this stage that it may well be possible to reach a compromise which would enable the Council to acquire the existing property. There is also the opportunity to incorporate some public access to Council services on the site, which of course will be very beneficial to residents in this part of the borough.

Despite recent claims by the opposition that the deal had been done and we were merely seeking votes, we remain hopeful in ensuring a police presence here in Hornchurch.

ACCIDENT REDUCTION PLAN

As part of this year's Transport for London-funded casualty reduction programme, a project has been launched which is proposing to reduce road accidents along Brentwood Road.

There have been fifty one personal injury accidents in Brentwood Road over the last five years. Of these fifty one PIA's, one resulted in a fatality, three were serious, fifteen involved pedestrians, twelve involved children and eight occurred during the hours of darkness.

In order to reduce this number of road traffic accidents, the proposals include, humped zebra crossings, speed cushions, pedestrian refuge points and together with clearer road markings.

Your local Councillors support any scheme that will improve the safety of residents and a proposed consultation will be implemented very shortly.

THE CROWN IS BACK

Returning for a second year, the crown is back in Langtons Gardens. This popular display has been funded by external sponsorship and will be in place until November.

For those green fingered folk who have an interest as to which plants are used, there's a mixture of Alpine & Succulents including Sedum, Echeverias & Alternanthera. These are clipped throughout the season to enhance the colours.
