### Winglety Lane Traffic Improvement

An experimental traffic scheme including a ban on right turns from Winglety Lane into Minster Way has been stopped, and a consultation will be held.

The scheme was put in by officials without review by the Council's Highways Sub-Committee or consultation with the public. Although local residents were impacted, your councillors were not consulted before. Legislation on experimental traffic measures allowed this.

When Conservatives delivered over 5,000 survey forms this autumn to get your views on local issues, this was reported as an important issue and the council has acted. There were 89 individual comments and an online petition with over 1,200 signatures.
