RESIDENTS ASSOCIATION ALLIANCE WITH LABOUR REVEALED

As we predicted, **the first act of the Havering Residents Association was to form an alliance with Labour, and install a Labour Mayor.** They also appointed Labour to Cabinet posts in Havering.

Is this what you voted for? John Tyler, a Havering Residents Association Councillor in Cranham, was principled enough to leave their group. But the new Emerson Park RA councillors have embraced their Labour allies.

Both the Emerson Park RA Councillors have already voted with Labour to gut our opposition to the ULEZ Charge - Sadiq Kahn's new tax on Havering.

ENERGY CRISIS

We know that the rising price of gas is creating challenges all over the world.

The Government has already committed £15Billion for:

- £400 Council Tax rebate for most households.
- £650 additional help for 8 million low income households.
- An additional £300 for Pensioners and £150 for the disabled.
- £5,000 for people fitting electric heat pumps.

A pensioner on low income will therefore receive £1,350.

Pensions and benefits linked to inflation will also rise in April by about 10%.

Fight Labour's 'Cars for the Rich' ULEZ Tax on Havering

Sadiq Khan is planning a £12.50 per day (£3,000 per year) tax on people who can't afford a new car. This will:

- Drive customers away from our local business and high street.
- Penalise the poor, who are less likely to have a new car.
- Make it harder to get NHS workers, Tradesman and Care Workers to work in Havering, as they have to work antisocial hours, visit multiple locations each day, or carry tools.

More proof that Labour just milk Outer London Boroughs like Havering for taxes.

This scheme will cost £200,000,000 of much needed taxpayer's money to set up and millions more to run every year. It would be better to spend this money on electrifying public sector vehicles and installing smart traffic lights to reduce waiting time and pollution.

Sadly, the Emerson Park Residents Association Councillors voted with their Labour allies to gut the Council's opposition to Khan's tax. Instead of using all means to fight the tax, they are just going to send a nice letter that Sadiq Kahn can ignore.
